Senior Citizen

• An Individual who has attained the age of 60 years and above.

Differently Able Persons

- Visually challenged persons
- Old and incapacitated persons and persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental retardation and Multiple disabilities.

Facilities to Senior Citizens and Differently able Persons

- 1. Shinhan Bank will open the deposit accounts as per the banks' policy which is as per the extant guidelines of Reserve Bank of India.
- 2. Shinhan Bank branch staff will always be helpful and kind and will provide priority in providing services.
- 3. Shinhan Bank will not insist on physical presence for giving requisition for Cheque books. The collection of cheque book requisition from the customer may be done by the bank branch.
- 4. Additional facilities to visually impaired customers is detailed in the Customer Service and Deposit Policy of the bank.
- 5. Door Step Banking may be provided for senior citizens of more than 70 years of age and differently abled or infirm persons. The facilities extended will be for pick-up of cash and instruments and for delivery of demand drafts. Other formalities to be followed as per the policy of the bank.
